

Medical Forms

- It is BSA policy for every person attending (youth and adult) to have current medical forms on file with the Troop
 - BSA Medical Form Parts A, B1, B2, and C
 - Copy of Health Insurance Card
 - Mrs. Hobss will reach out to those that need items on their forms completed.





Medications

- All prescription medication must come to Camp in the **original bottle** from the pharmacy. The label must contain:
 - The name of the camper
 - Date of prescription
 - Doctor's name and phone number
 - Correct dosage
- Daily pill containers are not permitted
- Turn in Medications to Match Medical Form Sunday Morning before departure

Uniforms

- It is required for scouts to wear their Field Uniform while traveling. White at camp they will need to wear it for Breakfast and Dinner. Shirt, Neckerchief and Slide, and a Scout Belt.
- A Troop 11 T-shirt for activities and weekend campouts
 - Blue and Red Shirts
 - Summer Camp includes 3 additional Shirts as part of registration
- Uniform Closet
 - If your scout is in need of uniform parts, the troop has some used uniforms available

 - Hand Sanitizer
 - Lip Balm
 - Insect Repellent
 - Sunblock

- Hiking Shoes
- Water Shoes
- Sunglasses

- Swimsuit (pack in day bag)
- Towel
- Cooling towel, highly recommended
- Gloves and work clothes for service project

Trading Post Money

- Spending Money (\$10-\$15 a day)
 - Either give to scout or divide into daily envelopes labeled with scout's name
 - Troop will hand out any envelopes turned in every morning





Expectations

If for any reason, discipline, illness real or imagined your child must return home. A parent or legal guardian will need to come and retrieve the scout from camp. The only other option is a parent funded plane ticket.





Camp Merit Badge Specifics FYI

- **Voyager - First Year Program**

They will have an overnight away from the main camp as a group. They will need a bed roll and personal tent.

- **Rifle and Shotgun participants.**

You will need to take hunter's safety. At camp the cost is \$20 but you have to pass the test on Friday.

- **Wilderness Survival your scout will need a bed roll, head lamp, and change of clothing.**
